Use provincial government resources to find healthcare:

2. **Health811** - Dial 811 or visit their website: health811.ontario.ca

Use IAMsick.ca to search for primary care providers or other healthcare providers and services in your area.

See if your local **Community Health Center (CHC)** is accepting patients in their primary care (or other) programs. Find a list of CHCs on **Alliance for Healthier Communities Website**: <https://www.allianceon.org/find-a-centre>

Reach out to those in your family or friend group who you know or trust to see if anyone's provider is taking on new patients.

Join a local mom group on Facebook or similar type of group for your city/town. Reach out and ask for recommendations and reviews - but make sure you cross reference these where possible.

In the mean time:

You can often access healthcare through your local community health center; and if not, walk-in clinic services, virtual walk-in services or access triage and nursing guidance through Health811. In an emergency, call 911 and/or attend your local emergency department.
